The Board of Directors (“**Board**”) of Galaxy Entertainment Group Limited (“**GEG**”) is pleased to announce that the grand opening of Galaxy Macau™, the newest integrated destination resort in Macau, will be May 15, 2011.

Galaxy Macau™ will be Macau’s first Asian centric destination resort and one of the largest leisure complexes in Asia. Conceived with “World Class, Asian Heart”, Galaxy Macau™ will offer approximately 2,200 hotel rooms under three leading Asian brands including Banyan Tree Macau’s 250 suites and 10 floating villas, Hotel Okura Macau’s 500 rooms and the 1,500 room Galaxy Hotel; the most diverse range of Asian dining with over 50 food and beverage outlets; and Asian themed entertainment such as China Rouge lounge & night club and the world’s largest sky top wave pool. Later this year, a 9 screen multi-purpose theatre will be added to further enhance the entertainment offering.

The HK\$14.9 billion, 550,000 square meter resort is in an excellent position to capitalize on Macau’s market growth and attract a new kind of customer, especially the emerging middle class in Mainland China.

We expect Galaxy Macau™ to be the only new resort destination to open in Macau until at least the end of 2011 and GEG will be the only operator with flagship properties in both the gaming hub of Macau’s Peninsula and the rapidly emerging resort destination area of Cotai.
